



TRGC Family Membership Policy

- A family membership can include two adults (over 18 years old) of the same household, and must include at least one adult.
- A family membership may include unlimited children under the age of 18 (do not need to be in the same household).
- In a family membership, one adult is considered the primary adult. The primary adult may obtain voting privileges within the association.
- The secondary adult is considered “honorary” and has no voting privileges.
- Children will be removed from the Family Membership on their 18th birthday.
- Children reaching the age of 18 may become provisional members. The Standard Membership dues rate will apply excluding the initiation fee.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult while on TRGC property.
- Family Membership dues rate will be 1.5 times the Standard Membership dues rate plus the initiation fee.
- Family Membership initiation fee will be double the Standard Membership initiation fee.
- Volunteer work hours are an additional 50% of the Standard Membership volunteer work hour schedule.
- Family Membership volunteer work hours are cumulative amongst all members listed under the Family Membership.
- If the primary adult does not renew his or her annual membership, all members listed under the Family Membership will be dropped from the TRGC membership roster.
- Current members wishing to switch to a Family Membership must submit a Family Membership application. The member will be billed the difference between the Standard Membership dues rate and the Family Membership dues rate. Initiation fees will be assessed as follows:
 - Current member adds children – no initiation fee for conversion
 - Two current members switch to a family membership – no initiation fee for conversion.

- Current adult converts and adds a secondary adult who is not a member – a single initiation fee will be assessed. New adult member must attend orientation and provide background check.
- No dues refund will be given to members converting to a Family Membership throughout the year.
